

NOTICE OF RACE

Jericho Classic Regatta June 7 & 8, 2008

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 CYA prescriptions will apply as well as the rules of the participating classes and this notice of race.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category "C".

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Skippers wishing to register boats in this event must be members of Good Standing of a recognized yacht/sailing club. As per ISAF regulations, skippers must be paid up members of their National Authority.
- 3.2 Eligible classes are: International Laser, International Laser Radial, International Tasar, Martin 16, International 505, X-Class Multi-hull (classes will be started together but scored separately, Hobie 16, X-Class Mono-hull and any multi-hull or mono-hull dinghy that is less than 18 feet in length and has a centreboard or dagger board (PRO discretion).

4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$30.00 CAN for single-handed boats and \$50.00 CAN for double-handed boats.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration will take place on Saturday 7 June between 10:00 and 12:00 hrs at the Jericho Sailing Centre.
- 5.2 Racing for all classes will take place on Saturday 7 June, and Sunday 8 June, 2008.
- 5.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first start of the first race on 7 June is 13:00 hrs. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first start of the first race on 8 June is 11:00 hrs.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 The sailing instructions will be available at registration on 7 June 2008.

7 VENUE

- 7.1 The venue for this event will be the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery Street, Vancouver, BC, Canada. The sailing will take place on English Bay.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be in effect for all classes except the multi-hulls and the Martin 16.
- 8.2 RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are modified for the multi-hull classes and the Martin 16 in that said

boats are required to do one 360 degree penalty turn including one tack and one gybe.

9 SCORING

9.1 The Low Point scoring system in Appendix A4.2 will apply.

9.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.3 (a) When 4 races or less have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

10 THE COURSES

10.1 The course to be sailed shall be displayed on the starting line boat or at the preparatory signal for each class.

10.2 The courses to be sailed are as follows: all marks to be left to port.

10.3 A course diagram will be included with the sailing instructions

FLAG	COURSE	MARKS
1	Standard Triangle	Start – 1 (1A) – 2 – 3 (3G) – Finish
2	Windward-Leeward	Start – 1 (1A) – 3 (3G) – Finish
3	Bermudan Triangle	Start – 1 (1A) – 2 – 3 (3G) – 1 (1A)- 3 (3G) – Finish
4	2 X Wind-Leeward	Start – 1 (1A) – 3 (3G) – 1 (1A) – 3 (3G) – Finish

10.4 A boat may finish either upwind or downwind depending on the position of the RC boat.

11 PRIZES

11.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top three sailors in each of the participating classes as well as top master, top youth and top female in the International Laser Class

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.
